

MANDATORY REGULATIONS & DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED AT REGISTRATION

All participants (or their parents/guardians) must complete the following documentation during registration. These forms need to be finalized before the participant's first class.

1. **Registration Policies:** Parents or guardians are required to review and adhere to the registration policies outlined below.
2. **Ninja X Academy Assumption of Risk Form:** This form must be completed by the time of registration. Adult attendees (such as those participating in a parent-child class) must sign on behalf of both themselves and their child.
3. **Code of Conduct for Parents:** Parents or guardians are expected to understand, accept, and follow both the written rules of the sport and the principles of fair play.
4. **Media Consent:** Parents or guardians must indicate whether they permit Ninja X Academy to photograph and record their child during class or events for use in print, digital media, promotions, or virtual competitions. Adult attendees must also provide consent for both themselves and their child.
5. **Bathroom Usage:** Children under 5 years old must be able to use the restroom independently. If they are not yet able, a guardian must remain in the facility to assist. Coaches are not permitted to leave their classes unattended.
6. **Spotting & Physical Contact:** In accordance with Ninja X guidelines, physical contact for spotting is necessary to support and guide athletes. Spotting for guidance helps athletes with movement techniques, while spotting for safety minimizes injury risks. High fives and fist bumps are also used to encourage and celebrate achievements.

By registering, you agree to the above terms and consent to the contact involved.

CLASS REGISTRATION & CLASS ATTENDANCE

Registration is the process of formally assigning and recording the enrolment of a student, usually in a course or courses.

Students may schedule up to **two make-up classes** for missed sessions per term, provided at least **24hours' notice** is given. All make-up sessions must be completed within the current term.

WITHDRAWALS

WITHDRAWALS & REFUNDS

All registrations are final. No refunds will be issued after registration.

Withdrawals due to injury or extended illness may be eligible for a refund with a specific written physician's note. A pro-rated, 80% refund is calculated from the date the note is received.

CLASS / CAMP CANCELLATIONS

Ninja X Academy reserves the right to cancel classes with fewer than 3 participants. Families will be notified via email, and participants may transfer to other classes. If no suitable alternatives are available, a full refund will be issued.

EXTREME WEATHER CLOSURE PROCEDURE

For weekdays, Ninja X Academy will follow the local public school district's closure procedures. If public schools are closed due to weather, Ninja X Academy programs will also be cancelled. Check local school board websites for updates. A notification will be sent to members confirming the closure.

For weekends, Ninja X Academy will monitor Environment Canada's weather alerts and notify members via email if programs are cancelled.

As weather-related cancellations are due to natural conditions beyond our control, no refunds or make-up classes/camps will be provided.

AGE REQUIREMENTS

Ninja X Academy's curriculum is designed with age-appropriate activities based on children's developmental stages. Children must meet the age requirements for each program on the first day of class or camp. Ensure that the date of birth in the athlete's profile is correct to register for the appropriate category. Contact the front desk if there is an error in the date of birth.

MEDICAL / LEARNING NEEDS

Ninja X Academy strives to accommodate all athletes' needs. Parents/guardians should inform the Program Lead of any allergies or physical, behavioral, or learning needs at the time of registration to ensure an optimal experience. Failure to disclose such information may result in withdrawal or transfer if a safe and appropriate learning environment cannot be provided.

ADVERTISING / MEDIA AND PUBLICITY

With parental consent, Ninja X Academy may photograph and film athletes for advertising and publicity purposes. Consent is requested at the time of registration.
